## Camp Philosophy

The 2019 Tiger Camp will be held at the Fort Hays State University Football facilities and directed by head coach, Chris Brown and the FHSU football staff. The camp will feature an emphasis on techniques and the fundamentals of football. The camp will provide an opportunity for individual time and instruction, competition, and team work. The goal of the camp is to ensure that each student athlete leaves camp a better football player than when he arrived.

## Team Camp June 9-11

The 11-Man Camp is open to teams with players entering grades 9-12. Overnight campers will be housed in FHSU dormitories. Campers must provide their own bedding and personal care items. Each team's coaching staff will be staying in the dorms with the campers each night. Overnight campers, and the commuters who elect to purchase the meal plan will receive generous, well balanced meals in our campus dining facility. Commuter campers who do not wish to purchase a meal plan will be responsible for their own meals and snacks.

## Head Coach Chris Brown

Chris Brown enters his ninth season as head coach at Fort Hays State in 2019. In 2018, Brown led the program to its second-ever Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association Championship and second appearance in the NCAA Division II Playoffs since 1995. By leading the Tigers to their second Conference Championship straight season The first time in program history, Brown earned 2018 MIAA Coach of the Year and Don Hansen Football Committee Super Region 3 Coach of the Year honors. In nine years, he has a record of 58-34 at Fort Hays State, showing consistent improvement each year.



Fort Hays State enjoyed its seven All-MIAA selections under Brown in 2018. Brown has now coached 95 All-MIAA selections at Fort Hays State, including 18 first-team selections. Fort Hays State boasted the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year in each of the last three seasons, Sie Doe, Jr. in 2016 and Nathan Shepherd in 2017. The New York Jets selected Shepherd in the third round of the 2018 NFL Draft, In 2018 Jose Delgado joined the list with Fort Hays third Defensive Player of the Year.

The Tigers have shown steady progress under Brown, with improvement in each of his seasons at the helm. After finishing with a 4-7 mark in his first year (2011), the Tigers finished 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, and 7-4 in 2014. In 2015, the Tigers went 8-4 overall with an appearance in the Mineral Water Bowl, but in 2016 went 8-4 again and won the Heart of Texas Bowl. The program saw a huge leap in 2017 with an overall record of 11-1, setting the new school record for wins in a season by three. In 2018 The Tigers went 9-3 with its second MIAA conference championship.

The Tigers have now enjoyed six consecutive winning seasons, their longest streak since joining NCAA Division II. The Tigers have accomplished that feat as members of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, arguably the nation's premier Division II football conference that has produced the national champion five of the last nine years. FHSU joined the conference in 2006.

Brown, a native of Liberal, Kan., is a 1996 graduate of Pittsburg State University where he recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts in his career at free safety. He is one of only three Gorillas to earn All-American honors three times. He was a unanimous All-American First Team selection his senior season and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year in 1995. He was also named to the NCAA Quarter Century Team for all players from 1975 to 1999 at free safety. He had a record 21 tackles in the NCAA Division II National Championship as a freshman against Jacksonville State. Brown was inducted into the Pittsburg State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006. He and his wife, Daphne, have two sons, Hunter and Hayden.
